PEPTA Opposition Letters Needed to Congressional Delegations

Rep. Devin Nunes (R-CA) has written to members of the U.S. House of Representatives, inviting them to cosponsor the PublicEmployee Pension Transparency Act (PEPTA). His <u>letter</u> stated, "The bill is designed to prevent the federal government from bailing out distressed U.S. state and municipal pension funds, and to rectify serious shortcomings in the financial accounting and transparency

practices ofthese funds." An <u>overview</u> ofthe legislation was also circulated that included numerous incorrect statements about the financing and disclosure practices of state and local governments and their pension plans, and called for onerous federal reporting requirements and steep penalties for non-compliance.

Lettersto your delegation are needed, urging them not to co-sponsor the bill or allowit to be included in any legislation under

consideration.PEPTA has been introduced in the last threeCongresses and was most recently added to legislation pertaining to Puerto Riccassistance, which may be considered as early as next month. National publicsector organizations representing public employers, elected officials, employees and plans, continue to stronglyoppose the legislation for being an inappropriate and costly federalmandate.
