

#### Annual DOI FilingUpdate

Ina Siren issued April 15, the Department of Insurance has advised that beginningwith fiscal year 2016, Article 3 and 4 Pension Funds are now required to filetheir independent CPA audit report with the DOI within six months of the close of the fiscal year. While most Article 3 and 4 Fund will not have a separately commissioned independent CPA audit, typically the municipal independent CPA audit includes this information for the Pension Funds. As such, for Funds that do not have separate independent audit reports, our recommendation is to file the municipal audit.
